



## Eleventh Annual aMAZEing Ballarat 2018

An exciting activity for your organisation, sports club, school or family and friends.

aMAZEing Ballarat is part treasure-hunt, part physical race, part puzzle, and guaranteed to be full time fun. aMAZEing Ballarat is also a charity event, with **all proceeds going to a local charity or worthy cause.** For 2018, we will be combining with Friends of Royal Park Buninyong Sustainability Group to assist BREAZE's One Dollar for ONE Watt Social Solar project. Entry Fee is \$25/adult, \$10/Child(U/18).

Groups of 2,3 or 4 will need to have all their wits about them and utilise each team-member's strengths to solve the clues and complete the tasks within the time frame.

Eureka Orienteers in Ballarat have set **Saturday December 1<sup>st</sup> 2018** 9.30am to 1.30pm, for the Eleventh Annual aMAZEing Ballarat. It is a combination style of event which will have groups of competitors having to simultaneously juggle map reading, clue analysis, physical challenges and mental problems, this year amidst the beauty and history of Buninyong.

Teams will be given a street map of the Buninyong township, a clue sheet and an event card, and they will have up to four hours to make their way by foot to the various locations hidden in the clue sheet, as well as complete challenges and collect items. Teams will be required to carry a mobile phone for safety reasons, but can "phone-a-friend" at any time during the event to assist them in solving the clues.

The winner will be the team which completes all required tasks in the shortest time.

- Companies and Businesses – a great social activity that will develop team skills beneficial to your workplace.
- Families and Friends – a fun activity where all members can contribute to success, regardless of age or perceived ability.
- Sporting Groups – a challenge that will enhance teamwork, create bonds and put thinking and action side by side.
- School Groups – a different type of activity where both sides of the brain are tested and the "tortoise might just outsmart the hare".
