2015-2016 Eureka Orienteers Inc Annual Report to Eastwood Leisure Complex Inc – AGM (16 August 2016)

The Eureka Orienteers celebrated 40 years since incorporation in 1975 by staging the 2015 Australian Orienteering Championships in Ballarat and forests near Ballarat. Eastwood Leisure Complex was the registration centre for more than 950 orienteers from all states of Australia, New Zealand and overseas countries from the 25th September to 4th October 2015. ELC also hosted a mapping seminar (half-day) and the annual Sports Trivial Night for more than 140 junior orienteers at the conclusion of the carnival. President Mark Valentine played a major role in the organization and coordination of the 12 events in 9 days. This event, the largest Australian Championships in 50 + years of Australian orienteering, owes its success to the cheerful cooperation of ELC staff in the smooth running of the registration, mapping seminar and junior social event.

- Staged National Orienteering League Sprint Event at Deakin Campus, Geelong, part of 6-event series (13th March)
- Staged 25th Eureka Challenge on 20th March at Little Bendigo School, Nerrina
- Total remap of Canadian Forest tracks by Tony Keeble in preparation for 29th May Victorian Series #3 at Scout Hall, Mt Clear
- New maps created for BUNS events at Progress Park, Prince of Wales Park, SMB Campus, and Delacombe Parklands by Roch Prendergast with the financial assistance of Australian Sports Commission grant
- New splits printer purchased by Ian Chennell to enhance results processing
